THE MUNICIPALITY OF STEENBERGEN IS HELPING RESIDENTS AND ENTREPRENEURS WITH SUPPORT MEASURES

The Municipality of Steenbergen is providing a number of support measures to residents, social institutions and entrepreneurs in our community who are dealing with the consequences of the Covid-19 crisis. These local measures are in addition to the measures taken by the national Government to help them.



The Municipality is helping the Food Bank so that food packages remain available.



The Municipality is providing digital tools (laptop or tablet) for home education to families who do not have these available.



The Municipality is contributing to families and the self-employed who do not have sufficient money to buy essential groceries.



Residents' initiatives which contribute to solidarity during the Corona crisis may claim up to € 10,000 instead of € 5,000 from the Initiative Fund.



Social institutions such as associations or village halls do not have to pay rent for municipal premises for the time being. The Municipality will contact them to discuss whether they need help.



Entrepreneurs can apply for deferral of payment of municipal taxes and advertising tax.

Assessments already imposed may be paid later. Other assessments will be imposed later.



Social Work (WijZijn Steenbergen) will receive extra funds.



Catering entrepreneurs are excused from paying rent for their terraces for the coming months.



If weekly markets are cancelled, the Municipality will refund fees to the market vendors.



The Municipality will refund fees for events that have been canceled.



The Municipality will pay invoices from entrepreneurs more quickly.



The Municipality will not send payment reminders to entrepreneurs.
